Inactivated suspension for injection adsorbed vaccine against Botulism diseases

STATMENT OF THE ACTIVE SUB-STANCE(S) AND OTHER INGREDIENTS:

Active substance:

Each 1 ml immunizing dose contains sufficient amount of toxoids and anacultures

- Clostridium botulinum type C ≥ 80% protection.
- Clostridium botulinum type D ≥ 80% protection.
- Other ingredients: Aluminum hydroxide gel: < 4 mg / ml.

INDICATIONS:

Botivac vaccine is used to protect cattle, sheep and goats against botulism. Onset of immunity: 21 days post vaccination. Duration of immunity; at least 1 year.

CONTRAINDICATIONS:

Do not vaccinate sick or stressed animals. Botivac should not be used in lambs, kids, calves less than 3 weeks of age due to the possible immunological incompetence of the very young newborn animal and competition from any maternally derived colostridial antibodies.

ADVERSE REACTIONS:

None

TARGET SPECIES:

Sheep, goats and cattle

DOSAGE:

- Administer subcutaneously, (preferably in the elbow region for sheep & goats and under the skin of the neck just in front of the shoulders for cattle) as follows:
 Sheep & goats:
 1 ml
 Cattle:
 2 ml
- Vaccination of cattle: Vaccinate with one recommended dose (2 ml) at any age.
 - First vaccination: vaccinate with one recommended dose starting at 3 months of age, revaccinate after 4-6 weeks of first vaccination.
 - Booster vaccination: vaccinate with one recommended dose annually.
- Vaccination of sheep & goats:
 - First vaccination: vaccinate with one recommended dose at any age, revaccinate after 4-6 weeks of first vaccination.
 - Booster vaccination: vaccinate with one recommended dose annually.

ADVICE ON CORRECT ADMINISTRATION:

- · Shake well before use.
- · Apply usual aseptic procedures.
- Avoid stress when vaccinating.
 WITHDRAWAL PERIOD:

Zero days.

SPECIAL STORAGE PRECAUTIONS:

- Store in a refrigerator (2°C-8°C).
- Protect from direct sunlight.
- Do not freeze.
- Keep out of the reach and sight of children.
- Shelf life after first opening: Use the vaccine within 8 hours after first opening.
- The vaccine remains stable for 2 years from production date stated on the label under the recommended storage conditions.

SPECIAL WARNING(S):

Special warnings for each target species: Vaccinate healthy animals only. Special precautions for use in animals: Not applicable.

Special precautions to be taken by the person administering the medicinal product to animals:

Although Botivac vaccine is an inactivated vaccine and is not pathogenic for humans; care should be taken to avoid accidental injection. Should accidental injection occur immediate medical care should be sought. Use during pregnancy, lactation, fertility: Can be used during pregnancy, lactation and breeding.

Interaction with other medicinal products and other forms of interaction:

No information is available on the safety and efficacy of this vaccine when used with any other veterinary medicinal product. A decision to use this vaccine before and after any other veterinary medicinal product therefore needs to be made on a case-by-case basis.

Any unused veterinary medicinal product or waste materials derived from such veterinary medicinal product should be disposed of in accordance with local requirements.

OTHER INFORMATION:

Bivalent inactivated adsorbed vaccine. Botulism caused by Clostridium botulinum causes heavy losses in cattle, sheep, and goats in most parts of the world, through high mortality in animals.

Control measures are based on strict hygiene and vaccination of susceptible animals.

Bottles of: 100 ml and 200 ml.
