

STATMENT OF THE ACTIVE SUBSTANCE(S) AND OTHER INGREDIENTS: Each (0.25 ml) contains:

- Active substance: A minimum of 10^{8.0} EID₅₀ of inactivated Avian Influenza (subtype H5N8).
- Other ingredients: Span 80, Tween 80, Thiomersal and oil adjuvant.

INDICATIONS:

To induce active immunity in chickens against Avian Influenza Virus type A, subtype H5N8.

CONTRAINDICATIONS:

Do not vaccinate sick or stressed birds.

ADVERSE REACTIONS:

Very rare: minor reaction may occur. If you notice any side effects please inform your veterinarian.

TARGET SPECIES:

Chickens.

DOSAGE:

- Broilers: Vaccinate 0.25 ml subcutaneously into the lower part in the back of the neck or intramuscularly in the thigh muscle at 1-7 days of age.
- Layers and breeders:
 - First vaccination: Vaccinate 0.25 ml subcutaneously into the lower part in the back of the neck or intramuscularly in the thigh muscle at 1-7 days of age.
 - Second vaccination: Vaccinate 0.5 ml subcutaneously into the lower part in the back of the neck or intramuscularly in the breast or thigh muscle at 6-8 weeks of age.
 - Third vaccination: Vaccinate 0.5 ml subcutaneously into the lower part in the back of the neck or intramuscularly in the breast or thigh muscle before laying.

ADVICE ON CORRECT ADMINISTRATION:

- Apply usual aseptic procedures.
- Bring the vaccine to room temperature.
- Shake the container well before use.

WITHDRWAL PERIOD: Zero days.

SPECIAL STORAGE PRECAU-TIONS:

- Store in a refrigerator (2°C-8°C).
- Protect from direct sunlight.
- Do not freeze.
- Keep out of the reach and sight of children.
- The vaccine remains stable for 2 years from production date stated on the label under the recommended storage conditions.
- Shelf life after first opening: Use the vaccine within 8 hours after first opening.

SPECIAL WARNING(S):

special warnings for each target species:

Vaccinate healthy birds only. **Special precautions for use in animals:** Not applicable.

Special precautions to be taken by the person administering the medicinal product to animals:

If the vaccine is accidentally injected to the operator, urgent medical attention is required.

Use during lay, fertility:

Can be administered during the laying period.

Interaction with other medicinal products and other forms of interaction:

No information is available on the safety and efficacy of this vaccine when used with any other veterinary medicinal product. A decision to use this vaccine before and after any other veterinary medicinal product therefore needs to be made on a case by case basis.
